PINRA - Professional Studies Justification

The Justification Statement can be a couple paragraphs or a full paper. The intent is to clearly identify to the Sponsor, the reason for taking this course and the value it has as an educational program. There are several questions that should be answered in the statement:

- 1. Why is this educational pursuit important for the interpreter's professional development?
- 2. How will the interpreter use the information gained?
- 3. Is it to address an immediate or time limited issue or long term learning?
- 4. Is the information of a unique nature or necessary for development of a specialization?
